## This funding will be used to

- Provide structured and strategic support to students in all areas of the curriculum
- Provide time for teachers to work collaboratively with their colleagues to enhance teacher practice and undertake provided mentoring opportunities.
- Ensure all staff have the resources required to enact the whole school improvement agenda.
- Provide opportunities for staff and students to engage with digital technology devices to support student learning.
- Build teacher capability to use technology to differentiate, improve digital literacies and improve learning.
- Improve transition processes in the early years to improve student outcomes.

## Our initiatives include

- Enhancing differentiated and inclusive teaching practices so that the learning of all students is effectively supported.
- Supplemented Teacher aide support for intervention programs for identified students.
- Consistent approaches in analysing data to provide differentiated support to students.
- Utilise and embed information communication technologies to support and enhance curriculum delivery for students.
- Purchase of additional resources to support and enhance Literacy and Numeracy.
- Providing coaching, mentoring and instructional rounds to teachers to share and improve practice.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Procuring additional human and physical resources to support curriculum delivery.
- Funding of a Head of Technology position to ensure consistency and curriculum alignment and to provide mentoring to teaching staff to improve pedagogical practice around digital technologies.
- Continuing Employment of five extra teacher aides to provide support to students through the 'Response to Intervention' Framework.
- Continuing Employment of a full time Guidance Officer.
- Building the capacity of staff through purposeful professional development activities.
- Employing a data coach to build staff capacity in a range of practices to gather evidence of student learning and to use this evidence to direct future learning opportunities.
- Employing an intensive behaviour support teacher aide to provide focussed and directed support to identified students.
