

UNIFORM POLICY

Goal

To promote pride in self, school and community.

Community Expectations

All students are expected to wear the P & C endorsed school uniform every day. Students who are unable to wear the full uniform on any school day should bring a note of explanation addressed to the Principal. It is expected that parents will arrange for students to be back in full school uniform as quickly as possible. As a general rule:

- Students must wear the school uniform every day and for all school organised excursions.
- Students who are unable to wear the school uniform will be provided with a uniform by the school for the day.
- Members of school sports teams must wear the prescribed team player apparel.
- Students must wear sun safe hats during outdoor activity (including PE lessons).
